Online games are a great source of enjoyment for children, but parents need to understand that online gaming environments can also expose children to strangers and inappropriate content. Online games can be accessed in multiple ways, including on dedicated gaming consoles, laptops, tablets, and smartphones. Parents can help their children use online games in a safer way by talking to them about the risks, setting rules, and using parental controls. This guide lists the most important safety and privacy settings for the most popular gaming platforms used by teens, along with links to support pages describing how to implement these settings. Nintendo Switch is a handheld gaming console that can play games both on the device and online. Users can choose from thousands of games, where they can play with others, create content, and use IM and voice chat. Nintendo Switch offers adult games and unfiltered communications, but also parental controls that can enforce game ratings, limit online contact, set time and spending limits, and monitor use. Sony PlayStation is a hardware gaming console combined with an online ecosystem of thousands of games. Users can play offline or online games, chat, message, share content, and watch movies. PlayStation offers adult games and unfiltered communications, but also parental controls that can enforce game ratings, limit online contact, and set time and spending limits.

Microsoft Xbox is a hardware gaming console with access to thousands of games. Users can play offline or online games, chat, message, share content, and watch movies. Xbox offers adult games and unfiltered communications, but also parental controls that can enforce game ratings, limit online contact, set time and spending limits, and monitor use.







Apple

Apple offers both online and offline gaming on the company's Mac computers, iPad tablets, and iPhones. The Apple App Store offers about 200,000 games, including online multiplayer games. Apple does not allow adult-themed games on the App Store and has its own age-based rating system. Apple devices offer parental controls that can enforce age ratings, limit online contact, set time and spending limits, and monitor use. Learn more: https://www.apple.com/families/



Microsoft Windows PCs are compatible with hundreds of thousands of online and offline games. Microsoft does not manage which games can be installed on Windows PCs, so games may include adult content. Microsoft offers Microsoft Family Safety, a free parental control app that can restrict which applications are installed, enforce age ratings, limit online contact, set time and spending limits, and monitor use. Fortnite is a very popular online gaming platform by Epic Games. Players in Fortnite can create their own environments and fight for survival against mythical creatures or against other online players. Players can send messages and engage in voice and video calls. Fortnite does not allow sexually explicit content. Fortnite offers controls that can enforce content restrictions, block communications, and set time limits. Learn more: https://safety.epicgames.com

Roblox is an online gaming platform that allows players to create and implement their own games. Roblox is very popular with young people, as over half of all children under sixteen have a Roblox account. Roblox prohibits sexually explicit content. Players can send messages and engage in voice calls. Roblox offers parental controls that can enforce age-appropriate content, block communications, and monitor use.
